## Blind Draw Corn Hole Tournaments at the Hershey Italian Lodge

- You must be a member of the Hershey Italian Lodge (HIL) in order to participate in any given Tournament.
  - o If you're not a member and would like to participate, you may join that night. The fee is \$35 to join and covers you for the rest of 2019 and all of 2020. (You're registering as a new member for 2020 and get the rest of 2019 for free.)
- There must be a minimum of 12 participants in order for the Tournament to take place. If less than 12 individuals show up, we will just have fun throwing bags, with no tournament structure. It will be practice only at that point.
- Tournaments will occur on Mondays from October 21 through December 9 in the Large Banquet Room. (Corn Hole will get canceled if there is a banquet or another event scheduled.) December 16 is a "snow date" and may be an option if needed.
  - o Each participant will pay \$10 to enter
  - o 6:00 PM Sign-in will open and will close at 6:40 PM
  - o 6:00 PM Players are invited to practice or grab some food and beverages
  - o 6:45 PM Blind Draw is completed
  - o 7:00 PM Tournament begins
- In an effort to appropriately notify everyone should a tournament need to be canceled, we are asking that folks register online. This is a free service simply to capture your name, cell number, and e-mail address. - A small portion of the amount collected from each tournament will be withheld for endof-session prizes, which will be distributed to the top three seasonal finishers:
  - 1st place 50%
  - 2nd place 30%
  - 3rd place 20%
- Remaining monies will be distributed to the top 3-5 teams, depending on the number of overall participants. (Team members split the winnings evenly.)
  - Please see Appendix A below.
- Teams earn points for winning games (for end of season prizes).
  - Wins in the Winners' Bracket are worth 2 points each
  - Wins in the Losers' Bracket are worth 1 point each
  - The first match of the Finals (Winners' Bracket survivor with zero losses versus Losers' Bracket survivor with one loss) is worth 2 points

- The second match of the Finals [if needed] (Winners' Bracket survivor with one loss versus Losers' Bracket survivor with one loss) is worth 1 point
- Winners' Bracket Byes are worth 1 point
- Your average at the end of the season will be the total points divided by the number of weeks you played.
- You must play in at least 6 Tournaments in order to qualify for the end-of-season payout.
- The tournaments will be double elimination.
- Boards will run length-wise in the Banquet Room, 27-feet from nose-to-nose of the boards.
- A coin toss shall determine the following (with the winner of the coin toss receiving the selection of each):
  - To go first
  - o Bag color
  - The side of the board where they wish to stand
    (It does not matter who tosses the coin or makes the call.)
- Players/ teammates must be on the same side of the lane, directly across from each other.
  (If one of the teammates has a specific side of the board they like to be on, sort that out within your team. Teammates may not be diagonal from each other.)
- Scoring will be to 21, with the winner being the first team to 21. Teams are allowed to go over 21, not having to score 21 exactly. Also, teams **do not** need to win by 2.
- Scores will be counted by cancellation (netting the two teams' throws against each other), with 3 points being awarded for a bag in the hole and 1 point awarded for a bag on the board (not touching the ground). No additional points will be awarded for "leaners" or "hangers."
- Any bag that hits the ground first and subsequently bounces up onto the board is considered a "dead" bag and should be removed before the next bag is thrown.
- Any bag that hits the ceiling remains "in play." If that bag then hits the board and is pointeligible, it is considered a viable bag for scoring points. (If it hits the ground, the above rule applies.)

- If there are an odd number of participants, the "odd-man in" will be a solo-walker and play alone until there is a first team that has been eliminated (picked up two losses). That team can discuss which of them will then join the solo-walker to complete the tournament. If both want to play, a coin flip will determine who plays.
- At the conclusion of the game, the winners should report to the scorer's table to report the result of the game.
