We recommend all boys interested in playing to register and come to the evaluations on Oct 22nd. This will ensure a spot in the program if they do not make their high school teams. Refunds will be given to those who make their high school team. *High school varsity players are **ineligible** to play in LTRC Basketball.*

****Travel Team Program**:** This program is designed for players with advanced skills and a high level of interest. All players trying out for travel teams must be registered to play in-house. Players assigned to a travel team must maintain good standing with their in-house team throughout the season. However, 8th graders who make both their LTRC travel team and their school team may choose to opt out of the in-house league requirement prior to the in-house team selection.

Travel teams are formed based on the grade level of the players, in accordance with AAU basketball's grade-based eligibility requirements. These teams participate in a travel team league and one or more tournaments. Travel teams practice one night per week (Monday-Friday) that does not conflict with in-house practice.

Please note that an additional fee is required for travel team players at the time of registration. This fee will be refunded to players who do not make a travel team or decline a roster spot. If a new uniform is needed, an additional uniform fee will be collected at the first practice.
