Volunteer Roles for SBYSL Indoor 2025

**Roles and Responsibilities**

- Head Coach

- Expectations:

- Have at least 2 seasons experience coaching (preferably indoor)
- Be present for opening day (12/7) and at least 8 of the remaining 10 weeks
- Communicate clearly with parents with reminders about game times, etc.
- Ensure balanced playing time for all participants
- Positive attitude!
- Guaranteed spot for player you are coaching

- Assistant Coach

- Expectations:

- Support for head coach in all items listed above

- Division VP

- Expectations:

- Participate in planning committee meetings (1 hour, evening, weekly or every other week, Zoom)
- Have at least 2 seasons experience coaching in SBYSL
- Administer division's team/player assignments
- Administer pool players for your division
- Take shifts as field coordinator (see below)
- Assist with uniform distribution
- Guaranteed spot for your player(s) in the division

- Field Coordinator

- Expectations

- Be present at Myers for 4-hour shifts (roughly 12-4p or 4-8p)
- Oversee referees (they will be assigned by the referee assignor; your job is to keep them on schedule and call for backup if someone doesn't show)
- Run the clock for games and keep start/end times on schedule
- Help resolve any issues that arise, with support from SBYSL officers, division VPs, and planning committee members
- Cash stipend to be provided for each shift worked
- Guaranteed spot for one player

- Scheduler

- Expectations

- Develop season schedule
- Upload schedule to GameChanger
- Be available to make adjustments to schedule as needed

- Referee

- Expectations

- SBYSL supports the development of referees alongside our players. Each week, the referee coordinator will assign games based on availability. With growing interest in our referee program and the high-intensity nature of indoor soccer, assignment priority will be given to referees who have demonstrated exceptional performance and/or are USSF certified.
